

## **COVID-19 Acknowledgment, Waiver, and Release**

In connection with the reopening of WoodWorks in-person events, we have established certain safety guidelines and protocols in compliance with, and in consideration of, the recommendations, directives, and orders of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC") and applicable federal, state and local authorities. These Safety Protocols have been developed solely for the purpose of mitigating the potential transmission of COVID-19 among WoodWorks guests and to keep WoodWorks employees safe and healthy. In light of the ongoing threat posed by COVID-19, in addition to evolving guidelines from the CDC, the Safety Protocols may be modified from time-to-time.

We recommend that before attending in-person event WoodWorks, you review the information provided by the CDC at <a href="www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html">www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html</a>. To the extent you fit within the CDC's definition of "high-risk" for severe illness from COVID-19, we strongly recommend that you not attend a WoodWorks in-person event at this time.

You are agreeing to follow the Safety Protocols and you understand that a failure to do so may result in you being required to immediately vacate the WoodWorks event with or without advanced notice by WoodWorks staff.

You acknowledge that you understand and agree to all of the following:

- (i) You will not seek entrance into an in-person WoodWorks event if you, or someone with whom you have had close contact, has displayed COVID-19 symptoms over the prior 72-hour period before the WoodWorks event or if you or someone with whom you have had a close contact has been diagnosed with COVID-19 until such time that you receive proper health clearance to exit isolation (if in the case of your COVID-19 diagnosis) or quarantine by a licensed medical professional or public health authority.
- (ii) You will not seek entrance into an in-person WoodWorks event if you, or someone with whom you have had close contact, has been diagnosed with COVID-19 until such time that you receive proper health clearance to exit isolation (if in the case of your COVID-19 diagnosis) or quarantine by a licensed medical professional or public health authority.
- (iii) You affirm that as of the date of the WoodWorks in-person event, you are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 or will have a negative COVID test within 72 hours of the event.
- (iv) You agree, with full awareness and appreciation of the risks involved, to forever release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue WoodWorks, its board members, officers, agents, servants, independent contractors, affiliates, employees, successors, and assigns (collectively the "Released Parties") from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, directly or indirectly arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained due to acquiring COVID-19, whether caused by the negligence of the Released Parties, any third-party facilities, or otherwise, while attending a WoodWorks event.



(v) You agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, directly or indirectly arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained due to acquiring COVID-19, whether caused by the negligence of the Released Parties, any third-party facilities, or otherwise, while attending a WoodWorks event.

I acknowledge and represent that I have read the foregoing Form, I understand it, will abide by the Safety Protocols contained within it, and I execute it voluntarily under my own free act and deed, including without limitation, the Release of Liability and Indemnification requirements contained in this Form. I further acknowledge that I am sufficiently informed about the risks involved in attending WoodWorks events; no oral representations, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing Form, have been made; I am at least eighteen (18) years of age and fully competent; and I execute this Form for full, adequate, and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by the same. I agree that this Form shall be governed by and construed in accordance with Washington D.C. law and that if any of the provisions included are found to be unenforceable, the remainder shall be enforced as fully as possible, and the unenforceable provision(s) shall be deemed modified to the limited extent required to permit enforcement of the Form as a whole. I agree that this waiver remains in full force and effect until the federal government and applicable state and local governments deem that COVID-19 is no longer an emergency.
